History:

This half-term with be exploring flight! We will learn all about how planes have changed over time and what effect this has had on our holiday choices. We will explore how the Wright brothers began this rapid technological change and how this has led to Neil Armstrong flying to the moon! We will learn how to order events in chronological order and predict what might happen in the future.

English:

This half-term we will be exploring stories from the same author – Julia Donaldson. We will sequence and retell the story as well as looking at comparison between our three books.

PE:

This half-term our PE day is **Tuesday**. We will master basic movements including throwing and catching, as well as developing balance, agility and co-ordination.

Science:

In Science we will be exploring materials. We will learn their names and all about their properties. We will become building inspectors and ensure our school has used materials that are suitable for its purpose.

Music:

This half-term we will learning to sing two new songs from memory and play instruments to match a beat.

Art:
