History

This half term, we will be continuing our learning about prehistory by looking at the next time period - the Bronze Age → Iron Age. We will explore changes in people's lifestyle including houses, tools and hunting techniques.



Art

This half term we will look at drawing and digital media linking this to cave paintings. We will explore different artists, craftspeople and designers working in different time periods as well as creating our own sketches and artwork on crumpled paper and other media to create the effect of cave paintings.

Mathematics

In mathematics we will be continuing our work on multiplication and division before moving on to study length and perimeter. We will be developing a range of mental and written strategies to consolidate our learning.


We will continue to focus on times tables, so it's very important the children continue to practise these at home both on TTRockstars and activities set on class dojo too.

Literacy

In our Literacy lessons we will explore a fiction text called The Fire Children: An African Folk Tale. We will explore the text, focusing on making predictions, using inference to determine how a character is feeling and answering questions about the text. Then we will create our own narrative based on this story.

In our grammar sessions we will be focussing on using a variety of expanded noun phrases and conjunctions to enhance their writing as well as recapping prepositions.

We will be continuing our new spelling scheme which the children have really embraced. Ask them all about their new techniques and games that have helped them learn their spelling patterns and rules.

Homework - Children can complete the tasks in any order and either place their books when they have completed a task or upload to Class Dojo.

Reading books need to be brought back in to school every day. Make sure you are reading at home at least 3 times per week.



Physical Development

This half term our PE sessions take place on **Thursdays**. Full PE kits should be worn all day on this day. That includes the red PE t-shirt, black shorts and jogging bottoms, school jumper and pumps.

PSHE

In PSHE we will look at
Managing our Feelings. We will
look at what our feelings are as
well as what feelings we may
experience throughout our day
to day lives. We will also
explore grief and loss.



Science

In science the focus will be on plants. We will be looking at the conditions a plant needs to grow and remain healthy as well as comparing different plants around the world. We will be designing our own investigations and growing our own plants.
