## History

In History we will be continuing our learning about prehistory by looking at the next time period - the Bronze Age to Iron Age. We will explore changes in people's lifestyles including houses, tools and hunting techniques.



#### Art

This half term we will look at drawing and digital media, linking this to cave paintings. We will explore different artists, craftspeople and designers working in different time periods as well as creating our own sketches and artwork on crumpled paper and other media to create the effect of cave paintings.



### Maths

We will begin with a topic on measurement before moving on to right angles and mental maths strategies for addition. Times Tables are very important. Please practise these everyday using Times Table Rock Stars.

# Sycamore Class

### PF

This half term our PE sessions take place on <u>Tuesday</u> mornings. Full PE kits should be worn all day on this day. That includes the red PE t-shirt, black shorts and jogging bottoms, school jumper and pumps or <u>black</u> trainers.

### **PSHE**

We will be looking at Managing our Feelings. We will investigate our day-to-day feelings and explore grief and loss.



# **English**

In our English lessons, we will explore a fiction text called 'The Fire Children: An African Folk Tale. We will explore the text, focusing on making predictions, using inference to determine how a character is feeling and answering questions about the text. We will then create our own narrative based on the story.

We will be continuing our new spelling scheme which the children have really embraced. Ask them all about their new techniques and games that have helped them learn their spelling patterns and rules.

### Science

In science the focus will be on plants. We will be looking at the conditions a plant needs to grow and remain healthy as well as comparing different plants around the world. We will be designing our own investigations and growing our own plants.
