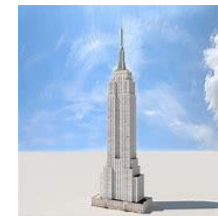


In Art we are learning about Greek pottery. Could you research the origins of Greek pottery, their uses and how they were made?
