
Literacy

Spring 1

Maths

We will start by looking at multiplication and division. They will then be using this knowledge to link it with shape looking at area and scaling.

Alongside this, the children will be practising their arithmetic skills daily and securing their times table knowledge. Please encourage your children to go on



to TT Rockstars regularly at home as this will have a positive impact on their reasoning and arithmetic skills.

PSHE

In PSHE, we will focus on how media can influence people. We will be looking at how images can be altered, how to report things seen online and why there are

age restrictions on social media.

PΕ

This half term our PE sessions take place on Wednesday afternoons. Full PE kits should be worn all day on this day. That includes the red PE t-shirt, black shorts and jogging bottoms, school jumper and pumps

In art, we will be linking with our history topic of Ancient Greece. We will be looking at Greek pottery, exploring using clay and then creating our own pieces.
