## **Welcome to Foundation Stage**

Welcome back to a new term.

We have a busy half term planned with lots of fun and exciting activities planned.

Our topics for the next half term will be Winter, Penguins, Antarctica and in Science we will be investigating the properties of ice. We will also be looking at the celebrations of Shrove Tuesday and Chinese New Year Friday we will be going to the sports hall for our PE lesson. Please ensure your child brings their full P.E. kit to school. All items of clothing must be clearly named and in a named bag.

In English we will be reading, retelling and innovating Emperor Penguin and Run away Iceberg. We will also be looking at some non-fiction texts about Penguins and learning a winter poem to perform.

Phonics: We completed Phase 2 of the phonics programme and we will be working on Phase 3 after a quick recap. Please keep practising their sounds at home and making simple words with the letter sounds they know.

We will add weekly support on Class Dojo. Please look at the school website for resources.

Reading: Please listen to your child read every day ,the books they bring home are fully decodable and therefore your child should be able to blend the sounds together to read the word. Positive encouragement and short daily sessions will help your child become a confident reader. Remember they can read their school book and also use <a href="https://home.oxfordowl.co.uk/">https://home.oxfordowl.co.uk/</a>

Writing: This term we will be working really hard on forming letters correctly and writing simple words and sentences. Please encourage your child to hold their pencil correctly when they are colouring and writing.

In maths we will be concentrating on numbers 1-10 and exploring 1 more/less, positional language, shapes with 3,4,and 5 sides and different ways of making the numbers eg:10 is made up of 3 and 7.

## Let's Get Talking.

As part of our focus on communication and language we are introducing a show and tell session each week. Your child will be chosen to bring something in from home that interests them and talk about the item with the class. It could their favourite book or something they enjoy doing outside school. E.g. dancing. We will let you know when it is your child's turn.
