Our topic this season is 'All About Me'. Please try the following activities at home with your child across Autumn Term. You can share your home learning with us by bringing it in to show us and then we can celebrate it.

Nursery rhymes

Nursery rhymes are so important for children's communication and language development. Talk to your child about their favourite nursery rhyme. Sing nursery rhymes together. Listen to nursery rhymes on YouTube.



Draw a picture of yourself

Draw a picture of yourself and name your body parts.



Recognise your name

Support and encourage your child to recognise their name at home.



Share a bedtime story

Share a story with your child before they go to bed each night. Talk about the story. What was your favourite part? What did you like the best? How did it make you feel?



Dressing at home

Encourage your child to dress and undress themselves including putting a coat on, zipping the coat up and fastening buttons.



Maths



Choose a Nursery Rhyme to learn such as 5 Little Ducks, 5 Current Buns, 5 Green Men in a Flying Saucer.

Can you recognise your numbers to 5? Can you touch count objects to 5?
