Literacy

In our Literacy lessons, we will explore the story, The Treasures of the Loch Ness Monster. We will explore the beautiful illustrations within the text inferring the characters thoughts and feelings, before writing our own version of it. After this, we will move into non-fiction writing creating a newspaper report based on a sighting of the Loch Ness monster.

<u>Spelling</u> - Spelling tests are every Friday. Please support your child at home learn them. Spelling is essential to children's learning and last half term, many children struggled with their spelling. Learning them at home by copying them out or using spelling frame makes <u>HUGE</u> difference.
