Literacy

In our literacy lessons, the children will be reading 'Friend or foe' by Michael Morpurgo. They will be learning about two young boys who are evacuated out of London during World War Two. We will look at creating descriptive writing, including a diary entry, a letter

home and concluding with writing our own short story. The children will then be looking at Rose Blanche which is a story of a young girl who discovers the concentration camps. The children will be looking at writing a newspaper report including the use of speech.

Spelling tests will be every **Friday**, the children will have their log ins for spelling frame sent home which will help them in their learning. Please practise the spellings with your children as this has a huge impact on their writing.

Maths

We will start our year looking at place value, identifying the digits and understanding different strategies to work out mental calculations. We will be looking at solving problems and further developing our reasoning skills.

Alongside this, the children will be practising their arithmetic skills daily and securing their times table knowledge. Please encourage your children to go on to TT Rockstars regularly at home as this will have a positive impact on their reasoning and arithmetic skills.

Art

In art, we will be looking at the work of Henry Moore with his underground sketches.

History
