This half term we will be looking at the celebration of Diwali. Diwali is the festival of light. Help your child to find out some information about Diwali and how they celebrate it.



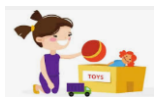
Practise recognising their name

Support and encourage your child to recognise their name.



Dressing and helping at home

Encourage your child to dress and undress themselves including putting a coat on, zipping the coat up and fastening buttons. Encourage your child to help at home by tidying their room or helping with the dishes.

Autumn Walk

Take your children on an Autumn walk and look for signs of Autumn, leaves, twigs, acorns, conkers.

Maths



Counting- sing number songs together, practise counting and recognising numbers to 3.

Count objects up to 3 matching the numerals.

Encourage them to count carefully and know the last number they say is the amount.

Can they show you 2 fingers? 3 fingers? Can they read the dots on dominoes up to 3 without counting them?
