In science, we will be looking at light and astronomy. Our focus question is, 'If it's daytime in England is it also daytime in Australia?' Could you create a solar system model or the different planets? We will also be looking at how the moon changes. Could you keep a moon diary to see how it changes through the month.



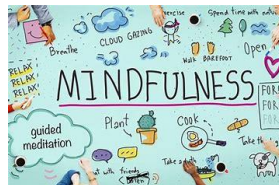
In computing, we will be learning about becoming game creators. Can you research different computer games and how they work. Can you design your own computer game?
