Punctuality

It is really important that children are coming to school on time so that they do not miss out on vital learning. This is usually the time the teachers explain what is happening during the day and start their lessons. If your child arrives after this time, it will be marked as an unauthorised absence. 10 unauthorised absence marks will trigger a penalty notice (a fine). We would like to avoid this, so please try to get your child/children here on time.
