

Literacy

In our literacy lessons, the children will be looking at different genres of writing and focusing on the grammatical features. To begin with, we will be looking at descriptions focusing on a fair ground. We will then move on to newspaper reports, writing a persuasive letter, an advert and a recount. We will be having daily grammar lessons focusing on sentence structure, punctuation and vocabulary choices.

It is really important that at home, the children are reading their home readers daily and reading for pleasure which could be magazines, books, comics or non-fiction books. This will have a positive impact on their writing and understanding with their reading.

Spelling tests will be every **Monday**, the children will have their log ins for spelling frame sent home which will help them in their learning. Please practise the spellings with your children as this has a huge impact on their writing.

PE

This half term our PE sessions take place on **Wednesday** afternoons. Full PE kits should be worn all day on this day. That includes the red PE t-shirt, black shorts and jogging bottoms, school jumper and pumps

Design and Technology

In design and technology, we will be looking at creating our own Ferris Wheel with moving parts.

We will be looking at creating our own music looking at different genres of music.

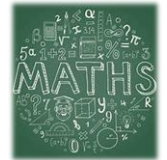
Geography

Alongside this, the children will be practising their arithmetic skills daily and securing their times table knowledge. Please encourage your children to go on to TT Rockstars regularly at home as this will have a positive impact on their reasoning and arithmetic skills.



PSHE

In PSHE, we will focus on how media can influence people. We will be looking at how information is shared online, how reliable different online content is and how much the media can influence our decisions in our daily lives.



Science

In science, the children will be looking at how humans change and develop as we age. We will be looking at a human life cycle and what we go through at each stage of our lives.



RE

In RE, we will be learning about Jesus and miracles. Our Key Learning Question is: What do we mean by a miracle?
