Welcome

Welcome back. We have a busy half term leading up to Easter

Our topic for the next half term will be Spring, Easter and Traditional Tales.

We will be reading Goldilocks and the 3 Bears, Little Red Hen and The Three Billy Goats Gruff and looking at the characters and how to retell the stories in our own words.

In maths we will be concentrating on numbers 1- 5 and exploring more/fewer, positional language, shapes with 3,4, and 5 sides and finding things shorter, taller, longer. We will be focusing on pattern and continuing a pattern.

In phonics we will be continuing with Phase 1 with the children. We are concentrating on rhyme and alliteration eg I spy an object that begins with s. snake (hearing that first sound)

Reading is extremely important and lots of stories read to your child is vital. Please read daily to your child and encourage them to join in and talk about the pictures.

Don't forget to look on dojo as this will be our main way to communicate with you. We will show you some of the exciting things we have been up to and how you can further help your child at home.
