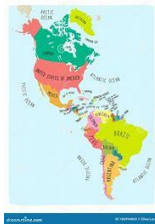

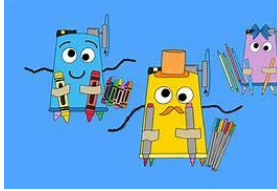


Research a country in the continent of North or South America. Create a fact file all about the country. Think about climate, special landmarks, population, physical features of your chosen country.



As part of our work on wellbeing and relaxation you can create your own zentangle design. Research what a zentangle is and then take time to create your own detailed zentangle design.

In English, we are focussing on writing and creating detailed sentences that engage the reader. Write a creative story of your own about anything you want. Remember that it should include description, action and dialogue to keep the story moving. Think about how it will start, what the main part of the story is and how it will end.



In DT we will be looking at electrical systems. Create a detailed design of a new game you could make which includes some sort of electrical system such as a buzzer or a light. You don't need to make the game just a detailed design.



Research a Greek myth story and pick your favourite one. Prepare either an oral presentation or a powerpoint that you can share with the rest of the class. Remember to detail what the myth/legend is about, where it originates and why you like it.



Each week you will be given some questions to complete for maths. The questions will vary from week to week and will provide revision of prior learning from Year 5 as well as new learning from Year 6 to help you in your upcoming SATS.

If you still do not know all of your times tables, you will need to continue to practise them to ensure you know the rapid recall of them up to 12x12. Please make sure you are logging on to TTRockstars at least 3 times per week to keep practising.

As well as the above, the following homework should be done every week:

- 1) Times tables – by the end of year 4, it is expected that all children know all their times tables up to x12.
- 2) Spellings/grammar – given out weekly. However, the list of statutory words that you should know by the end of years 3/4 and 5/6 also needs to be learnt.
- 3) Reading – this can be your home/ school reader, a library book, a magazine or comic or something else that you enjoy reading. Keep reading – it will also help you with your writing.
